Drones (unmanned aerial vehicles) have become the signature weapons of the Obama administration's air strikes in Afghanistan and Pakistan. San Diego is home to defense contractors General Atomics Aeronautical Systems, the world's largest and leading manufacturer of drones. General Atomics builds the Predator and Reaper drones.


